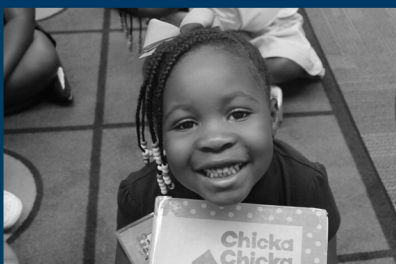
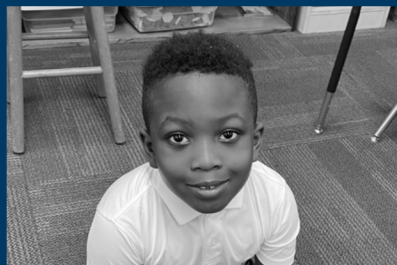
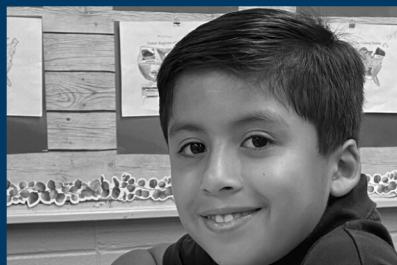
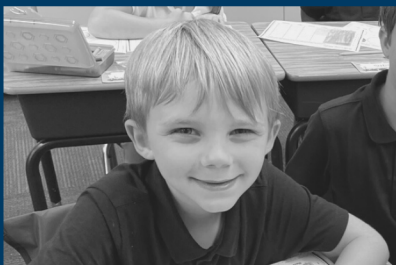
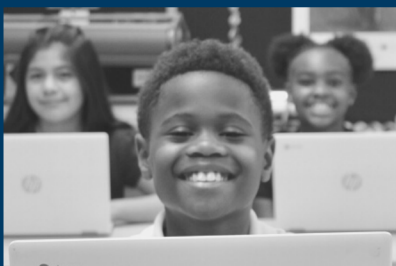




Montgomery Christian School ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

Our elementary students are the beautiful focus of our mission. From the ages of 5-11, every student is greeted by name every morning! Our amazing teaching staff knows each student's strengths and areas that need improvement. From inside the classroom to beyond, our students develop friendships, mentorships, and relationships that spur them onto success. This year we saw connections grow with alumni events, tutoring, our art, music, dance programs, and our new mentorship and counseling programs. 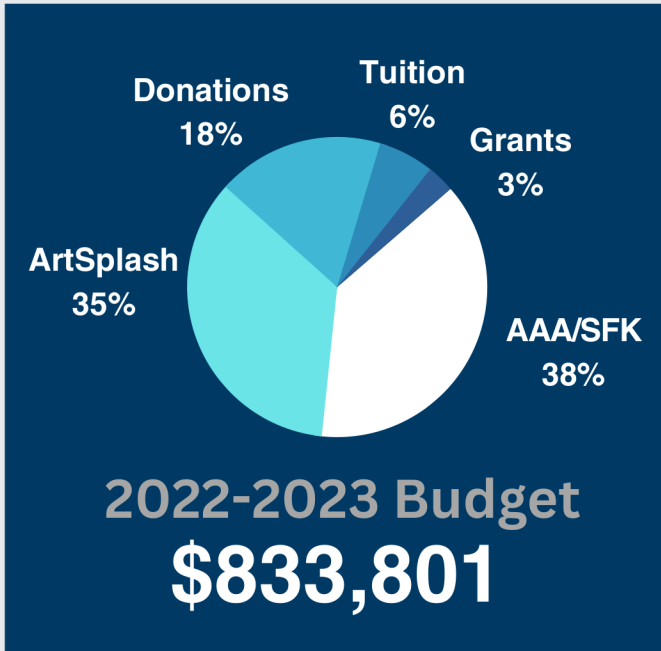
